Given the stated aim of the government is to increase nationwide pension saving, I suspect it will be easy to show that such disclosures are in the public interest.



The number of whistleblowers warning about UK companies failing to comply with pension law rose nearly a third in the past year, underlining the difficulties facing even small schemes as a parliamentary committee holds its first hearing into BHS's pension crisis.
