

# The views of EU workers living in the UK - troubling reading

Law Firm Baker McKenzie surveyed 250 EU citizens educated to degree level or higher. 56% said they were highly likely or quite likely to leave the UK before the end of Brexit talks. Moreover, as can be seen below, a very high % of them felt vulnerable to discrimination. Food for thought for the government, but also employers would be well advised to take steps to keep an eye on this troubling development.



The survey also found that 70 per cent of EU staff felt more exposed to discrimination since the Brexit vote, with 38 per cent of those describing themselves as feeling “vulnerable” or “very vulnerable”.
